
INFORMATION FOR:

In the Name and by Authority of the State of Florida:

JERRY HILL, State Attorney for the Tenth Judicial Circuit, by and through his undersigned Assistant State Attorney, charges that FRANK PAUL JONES on or about May 25, 2016, in the County of Highlands and State of Florida, did knowingly and willfully enter or remain in a structure or conveyance, not having been authorized, licensed, or invited to enter or remain in said structure or conveyance, the property of UNITED STATES POST OFFICE, or, having been authorized, licensed, or invited, did refuse to depart from said structure or conveyance after being warned to depart by the owner, lessee, or person authorized by the owner or lessee, and there was a human being in the structure or conveyance at the time FRANK PAUL JONES trespassed, contrary to Florida Statute §10.06. (1 DEG MISD)

COUNT 2: Informant aforesaid, under oath, further information makes that FRANK PAUL JONES on or about May 25, 2016, in the County of Highlands and State of Florida, did knowingly and willfully, resist, obstruct or oppose Steven Ratenour, an officer of the Highlands County Sheriff's Office, in the execution of a legal process or in the lawful execution of a legal duty, without offering or doing violence to the person of such officer, contrary to Florida Statute §43.02.
